1. General Qualification of Applicants

- 1) Be an undergraduate student of Prince of Songkla University, currently studying in the second year or above.
- 2) Have a strong interest in social contexts and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- 3) Possess good English communication skills.
- 4) Not be a student who is on academic leave or subject to any disciplinary action.
- 5) Demonstrate leadership qualities, confidence in self-expression, good judgment, and a strong sense of responsibility.
- 6) Be in good physical and mental health, with no conditions that would hinder participation in the program, and free from serious communicable diseases.
- 7) Must not have previously participated in the AUN Summer Camp program.
- 8) Registered for the course 071-N03 Exploring World: Culture, Life, Business and Sustainability – Insights for the New Generation, offered by the Office of International Affairs and Corporate Communication, via the PSU-NEXT U system, attend classes through the LMS PSU platform, and submit the assigned coursework as scheduled for at least four lessons.

2. Selection Process

Prince of Songkla University will consider and select applicants who meet the required number and criteria specified by the host university, as well as other relevant conditions. In this regard, Prince of Songkla University kindly requests the home faculties of the selected students to grant permission for the students to take leave from classes and/or examinations in order to participate in the program for the duration specified by the host university, to arrange make-up classes or assessments afterward, or to undertake other necessary and appropriate arrangements, as applicable.

3. Program Conditions

3.1 Selected students are required to participate in the program as specified by the host university. Such participation must be with parental consent and approval from the program chair, academic advisor, and/or course coordinators of all registered courses. The home faculty/campus is also requested to facilitate the students' round-trip travel arrangements.

3.2 If a selected student is unable to participate for the full duration of the program as specified in Clause 3.1, the student shall be required to refund the full amount of financial support received. In cases of force majeure, such as sudden illness, natural disasters, accidents, political unrest, or disease outbreaks, the home faculty/campus must submit an official letter explaining the necessity and circumstances to the International Affairs and Corporate Communication Center. The University will then consider the refund of financial support at its discretion.

3.3 Selected students must submit a participation report within 30 days from the date of completion of the program, together with an online media video clip documenting their participation, with a duration of 5–7 minutes. These materials shall be submitted through the home faculty, which will compile and formally forward them to the International Affairs and Corporate Communication Center. The University will subsequently issue electronic certificates to the participating students.

4. Expenses & Support

4.1 **The Host University** shall provide accommodation, meals, local transportation, and other items as specified by the host university.

4.2 **Prince of Songkla University (Home University)** shall provide financial support of up to THB 20,000, reimbursed based on actual expenses incurred, covering domestic and international transportation costs and international travel insurance (covering the entire period of travel in accordance with the insurance policy terms and conditions).

4.3 **Program participants** shall be responsible for personal expenses and any other costs not covered under Clauses 4.1–4.2. In this regard, the faculty/campus may consider providing additional support to students as deemed appropriate.

5. Required Application Documents

- 1) Application form (attached to this announcement).
- 2) One (1) two-inch photograph (to be affixed to the application form).
- 3) Parental/guardian consent letter.
- 4) A statement by indicates your interests, past experiences, or motivations for participating, ensuring they align with the host university's theme (max 300 words) using Microsoft Word, Times New Roman Font 13
- 5) PSU academic transcript for the latest semester
- 6) Resume/Curriculum Vitae
- 7) Copy of the first page of the passport, which must be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the period of participation in the host university's country.
- 8) Proof of course registration and submission of worksheets for the course 071-N03 Exploring World: Culture, Life, Business and Sustainability – Insights for the New Generation.
- 9) Proof of English language proficiency (if applicable)
- 10) Track record of leadership roles and/or contribution to community service (if applicable)

6. Application Process and Timeline

Schedule	Procedures
1–28 February 2026	Applicants must complete the application form in full and upload all required supporting documents by 28 February 2026 via https://forms.office.com/r/P8VpEffdue
Early week of March 2026	Announcement of applicants eligible for the selection process via the website: https://mobility.psu.ac.th/
2 nd week of March 2026	Selection process through both onsite and online interviews <u>Remarks:</u> 1. The selection results shall be in accordance with the decision of the selection committee, which shall be final. 2. For students from the Pattani Campus, the Faculty/central international affairs unit is requested to arrange transportation for students to attend the interview at the Hat Yai Campus.
From the 3 rd week of March 2026 onwards	1. Announcement of successful candidates via the website: https://mobility.psu.ac.th/ 2. The University will nominate the selected students, and the selected students shall complete registration in the host university's system.
April – July 2026	The International Affairs and Corporate Communication Center will arrange travel-related expenses for students and forward relevant documents to the home faculties.
Three (3) weeks prior to the departure date	The home faculty shall submit a request for approval for students to travel abroad through the Inbound/Outbound for Student system at https://io-student.psu.ac.th/ and shall also grant permission for students to take leave from classes/examinations, as well as provide necessary facilitation and support.
April – September 2026	Students will participate in the AUN Summer Camp 2026 at the host universities in ASEAN member countries.
